Port-au-Prince, March 9, 2005 (AHP)- The Lavalas activist Annette Auguste appealed Wednesday to the interim authorities to arrange her appearance before a judge in order that she may be informed of the charges that have been brought against her.

Sò Ann was taken into custody at her home in the middle of the night on May 2004 by U.S. soldiers.

She has been languishing in prison ever since.

"I have devoted my life to carrying out social work that benefits people in need and everyone is well aware of that", declared Sò Anne, adding that she is the victim of a political scheme and defamation.

She said she does not see very well what the provisional authorities are hoping to gain from keeping her in prison indefinitely.
