Funeral Ceremony for 11 young men killed by UN Blue Helmets in Haiti



On Wednesday, December 27, 2006, hundreds of people came from different neighborhoods of Cite Soleil at 3 in the afternoon to pay a last homage to their brothers killed by the soldiers from MINUSTAH on Friday, December 22, 2006. This intervention was called a “massacre” by many, and some witnesses report that more than eighty people were killed.

Children, youth and adults were all crying. But, those who were still living declared, with one voice, MINUSTAH must leave Haiti- we will not stop as long as the UN soldiers are on our soil.
