

# Have You Been Harmed by Cholera in Haiti? *Seek Justice from the UN!*

*The ongoing cholera crisis has killed over 8,000 Haitians and sickened over 650,000. The evidence clearly shows that MINUSTAH introduced cholera through negligent sewage disposal at a UN base. The UN has refused to accept its responsibility.*

## **The UN must be held accountable.**

We are working with cholera victims to obtain life-saving water and sanitation, compensation and a public apology from the UN. We are a part of a wide network of Haitian grassroots groups, community leaders, Haitian-American diaspora, scientists, health professionals, and members of U.S. Congress who are all calling for justice.

We are preparing to take the UN to a court in the US and are seeking US residents who:

- (1) **personally got sick from cholera** in Haiti OR
- (2) **lost an immediate family member** to cholera in Haiti.

The *Bureau des Avocats Internationaux* (BAI) is Haiti's leading public interest law firm. Since 1995, the BAI has prosecuted human rights cases, trained Haitian lawyers and spoken out on justice issues. The Institute for Justice & Democracy in Haiti (IJDH) was established in 2004 to work with Haitians in their non-violent struggle for democracy and human rights by documenting and distributing information, pursuing legal cases, and cooperating with solidarity groups in Haiti and abroad. In November 2011, BAI and IJDH filed claims on behalf of 5,000 Haitian cholera victims seeking justice from the UN. In February 2013, the UN refused to receive the claims, setting the stage for a US court case.
