Re: Demand for justice and reparation

Dear Council President:

I am writing this letter with great sadness. It is an opportunity to remind you that a person's human rights should be respected regardless of his or her social status.

My name is Telo Karistem. I live in a locality called Grand Bouelag, section Tomazo. I became infected with cholera in 2012. I was home, one day, when I started to feel ill, then I started to vomit, and then I had nonstop diarrhea. I rushed to the hospital where I was given fluids through an IV. The hospital is located in a locality called Dalon. I spent three days in the hospital. Now I am asking MINUSTAH for compensation, justice and reparation. The cholera has left me with a disease which makes me feel very dizzy.
