Caribbean Caucus Co-Chairs Waters, Clarke and Plaskett meet with the Commission for a Haitian Solution to the Crisis

WASHINGTON – On December 16<sup>th</sup>, Congresswoman Maxine Waters (CA-43), Congresswoman Yvette Clarke (NY-9), and Congresswoman Stacey Plaskett (VI), the Co-Chairs of the Congressional Caribbean Caucus, held a virtual meeting with several representatives of the Commission for a Haitian Solution to the Crisis.
